



As we look ahead to the rest of the year, may we continue to grow, learn, and celebrate all that makes Ekatva truly special.


EXTRAVAGANZA

CELEBRATIONS





The atmosphere was filled with chants, floral offerings, and quiet reflection—reminding us all of the power of knowledge, and the joy of learning.








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REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS









It was a day of reflection, pride, and hope—a fitting tribute to the values enshrined in our Constitution.











SHOOTING BALL TOURNAMENT

Who makes our future feel just like her own.




MEANING-



In short, mathematics is a helpful friend. It helps us in school and in daily life. Learning math makes us smarter and better thinkers.



- * fats


To maintain healthy eating habits, try not to eat too much junk or discretionary food products.
