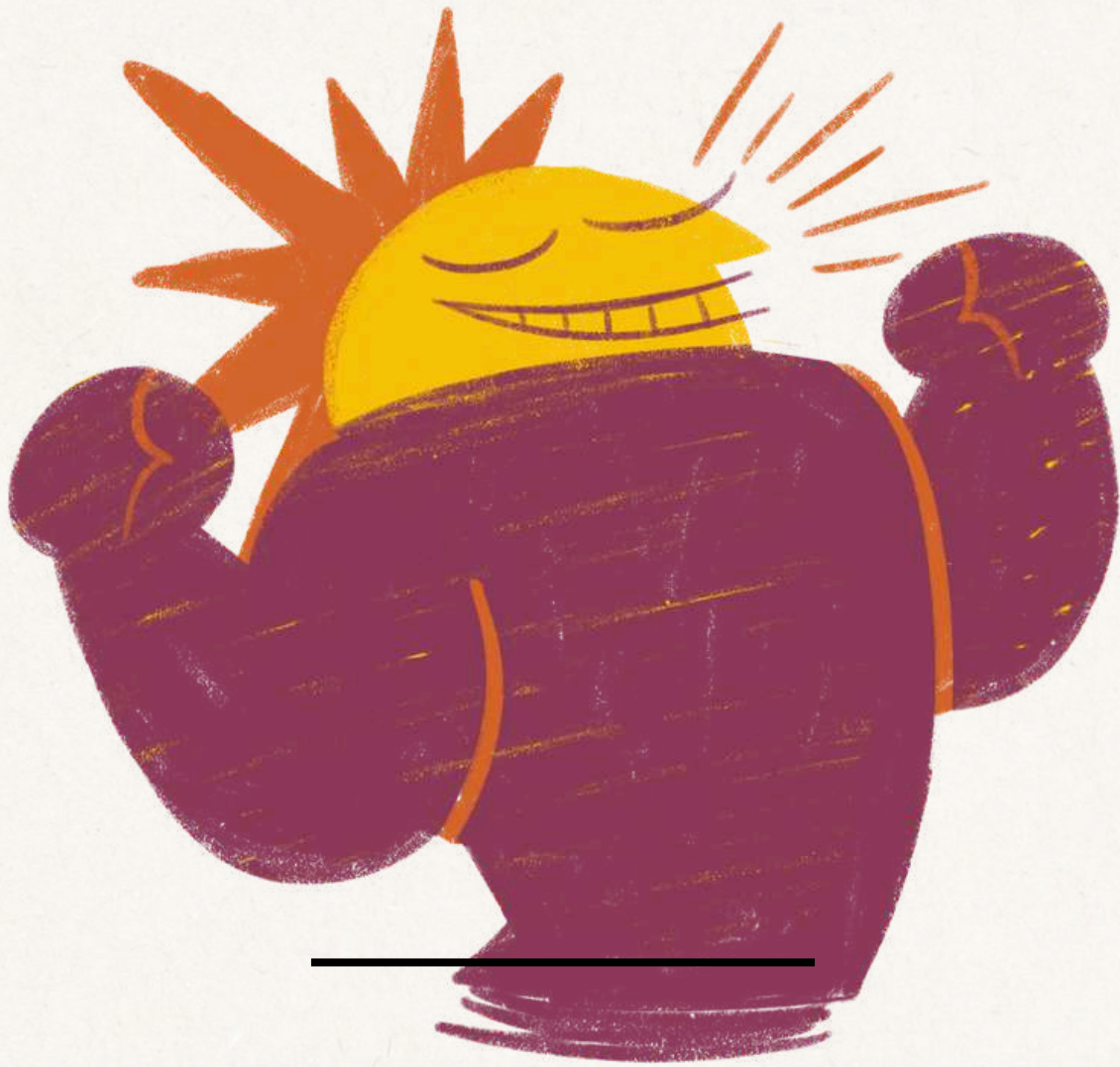
Conducted in a safe, supportive, and age-appropriate manner, the interaction encouraged students to ask questions freely and gain clarity on concerns often left unspoken.

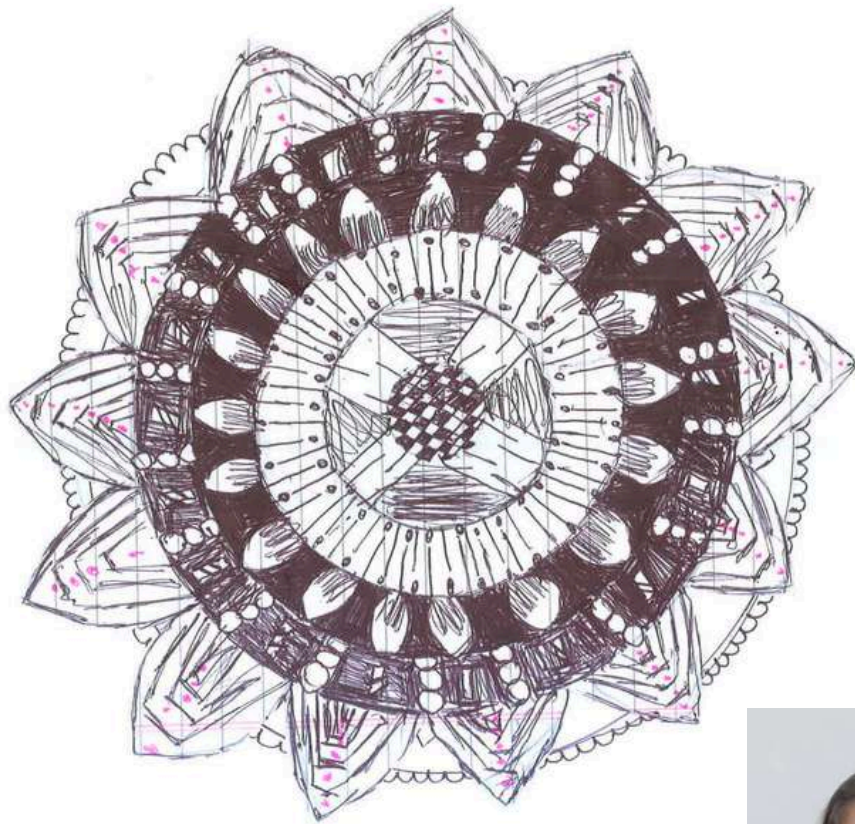
About My Winning Moment
